




<u>Allied Health Professions Australia (AHPA)</u> and its members are working to support allied health practices to better understand practice software and digital health technology.




What is the National Health Services Directory (NHSD)?

• For health professionals and consumers

 A national health service directory that all State and Territory governments are committed to ensuring is accurate and up-to-date

• Supports the growing national digital health infrastructure.

What information is included?

Includes General Practices, Hospitals, Pharmacies and Emergency Departments, Aged Care, specialists and Allied Health Professionals, Disability and Community Services organisations

Public Access

- Does **not** include practitioner names, just practice details.
- Contains essential service information such as location, opening hours and telephone numbers/contact details as well as appointment & accessibility information.
- My Health Record accessibility



If your practice is not listed in the directory you can register it here: <u>www.nhsd.com.au/register</u>



How is the directory kept up to date?

- HealthDirect team contacts providers to verify and update
- Self Authorship allowing service providers to manage their own listing
- Cross-referencing and synchronisation with other validated data sets
- Direct feedback from people using the NHSD through a range of online applications
- **Reminder notifications** to organisations with details which have not been updated recently.

- Supports integrated care by providing free access to information about available health services for patients
- Helps promote the availability of registered healthcare services and their contact & service details
